

Pastel colors are used to create this simple bed-size quilt using the Nine-Patch block with the Greek Cross block.

Nine-Patch Blocks

Step 1. Cut 10 strips lavender print 4 1/2" x 44". Cut eight strips floral print 4 1/2" x 44".

Step 2. Sew a lavender print strip to a floral print strip to a lavender print strip to make an A strip set; repeat for four A strip sets. Sew a floral print

strip to a lavender print strip to a floral print strip to make a B strip set; repeat for two B strip sets.

Step 3. Cut A and B strip sets into 4 1/2" segments as shown in Figure 1; you will need 36 A segments and 18 B segments.



Cut strip sets into 4 1/2" segments.





Step 4. Sew a B segment between two A segments to

complete one Nine-Patch block as shown in Figure 2; repeat for 18 blocks.

Greek Cross Blocks

Step 1. Cut two strips lavender print 4 1/2" x 44". Cut eight strips each peach print and white solid 2 1/2" x 44".

Greek Cross

Materials

- 1 1/4 yards peach print
- 1 1/2 yards white solid
- 1 3/4 yards floral print
- 2 3/4 yards lavender print
- Backing 76" x 100"
- Batting 76" x 100"
- 9 3/4 yards self-made or purchased binding
- All-purpose thread to match fabrics
- Clear nylon monofilament
- Basic sewing supplies, disappearing marker, rotary cutter, self-healing mat and acrylic ruler

Step 2. Sew a peach print strip to a white solid strip to make a C strip set; press seam toward the peach print strip; repeat for eight C strip sets.

Step 3. Sew a C strip set to each side of a lavender

print strip to make a D strip set as shown in Figure 3; press seams toward C strip set. Repeat for two D strip sets.

Step 4. Cut D strip sets into 4 1/2" segments, again referring



to Figure 3 to make D-C units. You will need 17 D-C units.

Step 5. Cut remaining C strip sets into 4 1/2" units as shown in Figure 4; you will need 34 C units.



Step 6. Cut five

strips each floral print and white solid 4 7/8" x 44". Cut each strip into 4 7/8" square segments for E. You will need 34 squares of each color.

Step 7. Lay a floral print square right sides together with a white solid square. Draw a line through one diagonal of the white solid square using the disappearing marker as shown in Figure 5. Stitch 1/4" away on each side of the line as shown in Figure 6; cut apart on drawn line to make E units as shown in Figure 7. Repeat for all floral print and white solid squares; you will need 68 E units.

Step 8. Open each E unit; press seam toward floral print triangle.



Step 9. Sew an E unit to opposite sides of a C unit as shown in Figure 8; repeat for all C and E units.

Step 10. Sew a D-C unit between two E-C units to complete one Greek Cross block as shown in Figure 9; repeat for 17 blocks.




Assembly

Step 1. Join three Nine-Patch blocks with two Greek Cross blocks to make an A row; repeat for four A rows. Press seams in one direction.

Step 2. Join three Greek Cross blocks with two Nine-Patch blocks to make a B row; repeat for three B rows. Press seams in the opposite direction of A rows.

Step 3. Join A and B rows, beginning and ending with A rows; press seams in one direction.

Step 4. Cut and piece two strips each peach print 2 1/2" x 88 1/2" and 2 1/2" x 60 1/2". Sew the shorter strips to the top and bottom and longer strips to the longer sides; press seams toward strips.

Step 5. Cut and piece two strips each lavender print 4 1/2" x 96 1/2" and 4 1/2" x 64 1/2". Sew the shorter strips to the top and bottom and longer strips to the longer sides; press seams toward strips.

Step 6. Prepare quilt for quilting and finish as desired. *
