

Free Crochet Angel Pattern

About the yarn

Body:

Round 1: Form a magic ring, 2ch, 11dc in the ring. (12dc)

Round 2: (2ch, 1dc) in first dc, 2dc in every next dc. (24dc)

Round 3: 2ch in first dc, 2dc in next dc, [1dc in next dc, 2dc in next dc] x 11. (36dc)

Leave a long end.

Head:

The head is round 1 from the body with a long end and beginning.

Wings:

Round 1: Form a magic ring, 2ch, 6dc in the ring. (7dc) Turn.

Round 2: 6ch, 4dtr between first 2 stitches from round 1, 5dtr between next stitches, [1dc between next stitches] 2x, 5dtr between next stitches, 4dtr between next stitches, 6ch, slst in 2nd beginning ch from round 1. Leave a long end.



Fold the body in half and sew about 6 stitches together and weave in end.



Fold it back like this.



Sew the wings on the back.



Use the end of the head to put through body and wings.



Tie together with beginning of the head, pull tight.



Weave in end and beginning.



And YES you're finished!
