

Trellis Shawl

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Wingspan: 57½"

Width (at the widest point): 40"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Garden™ (100% Micro Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g 284yds/260m)

• 1076-01 Gem – 3 balls

Hook: US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook *or size* needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

14 dc x 8 rows = 4"

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Increase Row: Ch 2, 2 dc in first st, dc in each dc across, turn – 1 stitch inc'd.

Diamond Stitch

Row 1: Ch 2, 2 dc in first dc, *ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc; rep from * across, 1 more dc in same sp as last dc, turn – 2 sts inc'd.

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first dc, 1 sc in next dc, *1 sc in ch-1 sp, 1 sc in dc; rep from * across, end 1 sc in last dc, turn – 1 st inc'd.

Row 3: Ch 2, 2 dc in first sc, *sk 3 sc, 3 dc in next sc; rep from * across, 1 dc in last dc, turn – 2 sts dec'd.

Row 4: Ch 2, 2 dc in first dc, ch 3, *dc 3 tog, ch 3; rep from * across to last 2 dc, dc 2 tog, turn – 6 sts inc'd.

Row 5: Ch 1, 2 sc in first dc, *3 sc in ch-3 sp, 1 sc in dc; rep from * across, 1 dc in last st, turn – 1 st inc'd.

Row 6: Ch 2, 2 dc in first sc, *ch 1, sk next sc, dc in next sc; rep from * across, turn – 1 st inc'd.

Row 7: Ch 2, dc in first dc, *1 dc in ch-1 sp, 1 dc in dc; rep from * across, dc in last dc, turn.

PATTERN NOTES

This wrap is worked from one end to the other. Increasing at one edge creates the triangle shape.

SHAWL

Setup

Row 1: Ch 3, 2 dc in 3^{rd} ch from hk, turn – 2 dc.

Work Increase Row 9 times – 11 dc.

Work **Diamond Stitch** Rows 1-7 – 20 dc.

*Work **Increase Row** 7 times – 27 dc. Work **Diamond Stitch** Rows 1-7 – 36 dc. ** Rep from * to ** 6 more times – 132 dc.

Work **Increase Row** 7 times – 139 dc. Cut yarn and fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
