- *Toy stuffing / Filling cotton*
- *Scissor, Sewing needle, Round counter, Pin needles*

You crochet in spiral round and the work will NOT be closed at the end with a slst. If you need to work in row's I will mention it in the pattern.

I always stuff quiet strong till nothing will fit in. Especially with body and head this is important – fill always small little pieces in – with the middle finger and the pointer of both hands in the work and place the stuffing good in the bends so you get a space in the middle that you can fill up. If you should just fill a little this is also mentioned in the pattern.

Begin to fill well and shapely. Fill the filling cotton nicely into the curves. In the end, make sure that the bottom is rather flat and does not bulge too much.

Cast off and leave a tail to sew it on. Place the inner ears on the ears and sew them on.

Cast off, close the hole and hide the yarn. Press the eyes flat and glue the half pearls on. The eyes are later sewn on with white sewing thread or glued on with the hot glue gun.

Fill the cheeks only lightly with filling cotton. Place the ends on top of each other and crochet together with 6 single crochets. Cast off and leave a tail to sew on. Rub the cheeks a little between your fingers so that the filling cotton is better distributed.

Cast off, close the hole and hide the yarn. Embroider paws in black. Tie a knot in the end of the thread. Insert the needle into a larger mesh hole and guide it to the starting position. The knot now slips through the tap hole, gets stuck inside and the thread is stuck. Now you can embroider the paw. Hide the yarn.

Now all the following stitches are worked in the ring:
4 treble crochet
3 double crochet
2 treble crochet
3 double crochet
4 treble crochet
3 chains
Close the round with a slip stitch in the ring

Cast off and hide the yarn. It is sewn on later with sewing thread, or glued.



Small paws 3x in black and 3x in light pink:

01. Magic-Ring, alternatively start with 2 ch and then go this way in first ch:
1 single crochet
1 half double crochet
2 double crochet
1 half double crochet
1 single corchet
Close the round with a slip stitch in the first single crochet

Cast off and hide the yarn. It is sewn on later with sewing thread, or glued.



Tail in colors caramel and black. You start with caramel:

The tiger stripes are crocheted in 3 sizes and in a row. That means you end up making a turn chain and turning the work around.

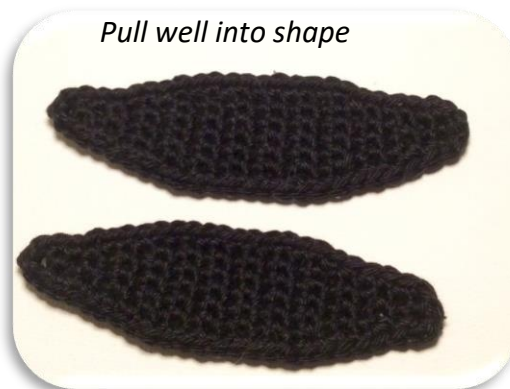
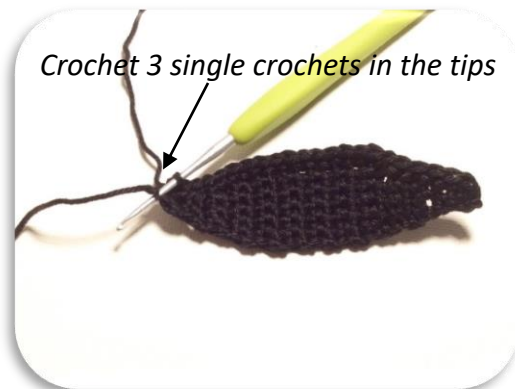
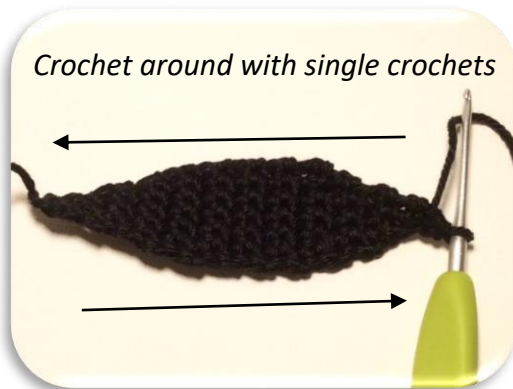

Crochet once around with single crochet. Crochet 3 single crochets in the tips, then the curve looks nicer. Cast off, sew the threads and pull them lengthily into shape.



The assembly

First everything, except for the tail, is attached with pins so that you can still correct the positions. The central point is the tongue. Please fix everything according to the photos. Fill the feet with filling cotton before plugging in.



Does everything look nice to you? Otherwise correct something again. Then we can now start sewing. Please take everything off, except for the tongue and the strips..

Sew on the top edge of the tongue. The strips are sewn on with black sewing thread. If you sew them on with black wool, it happens that when you pierce, some of the filling cotton always sticks to the thread and that doesn't look so nice.



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Attach the cheek just above the edge of the tongue. Sew the cheeks flat on the edge, then guide the needle a bit towards the outside of the cheek and sew the cheek with small stitches. Sew the second cheek and sew the gap between the two cheeks, also with a few stitches.



Fasten nose and eyes. Sew on the nose with black thread and the eyes with white thread.

Alternatively, I prefer the hot glue gun if the cat is not intended for a small child. It is rock solid and looks clean. I am not responsible for burns the fingers 😊



Attach the ears and sew around with small stitches.



Pin on feet, sew on all around and fill vigorously with filling cotton shortly before the end.



Attach the paws, sew on with pink and black sewing thread or glue on with hot glue.



Pin the hands and sew them on.



Attach the tail to the buttocks, sew it on, pass the thread through the body and attach the tail to the body with a few small stitches.



Embroider eyebrows with black wool. Mark the puncture positions with pins. As with the hands, make a knot in the end of the thread and insert it into a slightly larger stitch hole so that the knot slips inwards and the thread is anchored. In the caramel color, tie in 4 threads at the top of the head.



Pull 4 whiskers (brown or black nylon cord) on each side of the cheeks. Bend one half outwards and fix with transparent drying glue. After drying, cut to the desired length.



Whiskers alternative: You cut longer threads out of brown or black wool. Put some liquid glue in the palm of your hand. Pull one thread through each closed hand so that the thread is thinly moistened with the adhesive. Lay the thread straight on a piece of aluminum foil. After about 2 hours it is nice and hard and can be used as a whisker.



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
