### US terms

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

sl st = slip stitch

Stitches divisible by 6+1

(In my example 253 stitches)

1. row : dc whole row

2. row : ch 4, skip 1, dc in next stitch. Whole row  
( ch 1, skip 1, dc in next stitch)

3 . row : ch 3, \*dc in ch-space p, dc in next dc\* \*-  
\*repeat

4. row : ch 4, (dc ,ch 1, dc , ch1) in first stitch. \*skip  
2 , sl, ch 1, skip 2 , into next stitch = (dc, ch 1, dc,  
ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1) (together 5 dc in  
one stitch)\* \*-\* repeat. Skip 2 , sl, ch 1, skip 2 . In  
last stitch : (dc , ch 1, dc , ch 1, dc)

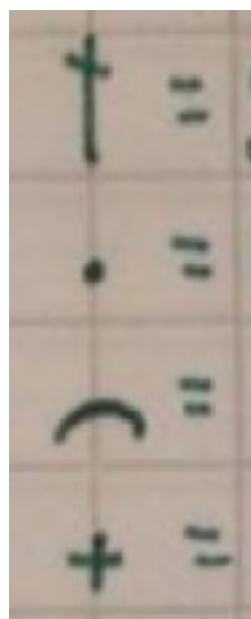
5. Row : ch 1, sc in first stitch , \*ch 5, sc in middle  
stitch of the farn\* \*-\* repeat. Sc in last stitch .

6. Row : ch 3, \*5 dc in ch-space, dc in sc \* \*-  
\*repeat till end

Work row 1-6 , repeat row 2-6 as much you want
